## THY WORD

“Thy word is true from the beginning, and every one of Thy righteous judgments endureth forever.”  
Psalm 119:160

I met Frank Craig in 1990 in Henderson, Texas. He was 93 years old, as I recall. He had read through the Bible twice in 1989 - using a magnifying glass.

Besides his loving attitude and dedication, the great impression left on me was Frank Craig's simple lifestyle and his focus. He didn't let anything distract him from his objective - not old age, not diminished energy, not failing eyes, not complicated living. And the magnifying glass hovered only over the precise Scripture of the moment, framing the few words from God in its view, satisfying the hunger in Frank's soul.

“O, how I love Thy law,” the Psalmist of chapter 119 said, “it is my meditation all the day” (verse 97).

It comforts in affliction (verse 50), redirects missteps (verse 59), cleanses our way (9), keeps from sin (11), removes reproach and contempt (22), strengthens in heaviness (28), gives hope (943), teaches good judgment and knowledge (66), makes you wiser than your enemies and teachers and predecessors (98-100).

How much the Bible has been through me hinges on how much I've been through the Bible. “They that fear Thee will be glad when they see me, because I have hoped on Thy word” (74).

Great peace have they that love Thy law (165). They walk an enlightened path (105). They are kept close to salvation (155).
