MAN'S TOMORROW

Revelation 21:1-7

On a clear day you can see all the way into tomorrow. Two and a half miles of water separate Russian-owned Big Diomed Island from Alaska's Little Diomed. When the weather is good you can see tomorrow from the American side. Between the two runs the International Date Line.

Humankind has a preoccupation with tomorrow. So much is uncertain that we hang onto tidbits of prophecy, however questionably based. We listen expectantly as the meteorologists predict the weather for a day or two ahead, though they may have missed the forecast altogether for the week before. We are most attentive when the doctor gives his diagnosis, and particularly when he states the prognosis of what to anticipate in the future. And really all the predictions are guess work, however scientifically calculated. There is no guarantee in this life what the conditions will be exactly in an hour from now, or whether I'll be dead or alive.

But there is one, and only one, source of information available to man that is totally reliable about coming certainties. God's Scripture has a definite view of tomorrow. Of course that tomorrow is the very last day there will ever be for mankind, and it comes at different times for us, depending on our length of earth life. That great eternal day for me is as near as the second coming of the Christ or my physical death. It will last forever and ever. No day after tomorrow then. We dare not delay till that tomorrow the vital business of readying for it. What you are when that time comes will be what you will always be, so be the best you can now.

When your vision is clear and focused in the right direction you will see across the Universal Date Line between earth time and heavenly eternity into God's tomorrow for you. As we look from earth into heaven with the Apostle John in the Revelation book, we get the only predictable view of the only tomorrow we are assured of if we are resurrected to life in God's Immortal Springtime.
